

# VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT - 2022/2023 SEASON

Fundraising is a necessary component to keep the costs of our programs down, making it affordable for families.

## Volunteer Requirements:

Participation in fundraising is mandatory for the families of each skater in the Intro to Figure Skating Program and StarSkate/CompetitiveSkate programs.

The club was granted a competition early within the skating year, therefore our priority is to cover these volunteer shifts. The competition is being held September 30<sup>th</sup> to October 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Genesis Place Arenas. Although we do plan on arranging other volunteer and fundraising opportunities in the future, these are still being planned. We would encourage as many people to sign up for the competition as possible.

We require all skating families to complete a set number of credits by February 2023. If the volunteer requirements are not met, a payment will be required from the family for \$250.00 for Intro to Figure Skating and \$350.00 for StarSkate/CompetitiveSkate.

If the family has more than one skater in these programs, requirements will only be required for one skater (the one at the highest level).
